Detailed Agenda for the review meeting of PMAY-G on 27th July, 2018 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi

- a) Confirmation of data on landless beneficiaries provided during the Annual Action Plan Meeting. **The format in which the information is to be furnished by States / UTs is at Annexure - I.**
- b) Action plan for month-wise completion of PMAY-G houses against targets assigned by December, 2018. **The format in which the information is to be furnished by States / UTs is at Annexure - II.**
- c) Status of progress of identification of additional households for inclusion in Permanent Wait List (PWL) and uploading on AwaasSoft using Awaas+ and likely number of additional households. **The format in which the information is to be furnished by States / UTs is at Annexure - III.**
- d) The proposal, if any, on interchanging of targets among different categories / surrender of targets vis-à-vis the Permanent Wait List.
