Subject: Completion of pending Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) Houses and closure of the scheme – Reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the above mentioned subject and state that a meeting pertaining to discussion with States/UT's regarding closure of Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) was scheduled to be held in the third week of June 2018. However, the said meeting could not be held since the information sought vide this Ministry's letter dated 28th May, 2018 could not be received from certain States/UT's.

Now, it is proposed to hold a meeting on the same under the Chairmanship of Secretary Department of Rural Development, Government of India in the last week of July 2018. Tentative Agenda for the meeting is being circulated separately.

With reference to a letter of this Ministry of even no dated 22nd January 2018 the States/UT's were requested to complete the incomplete IAY houses by 31st March 2018. Hence, the onus of completion of incomplete IAY houses lies with the States/UT's; however to understand and ascertain the financial liability on this count, the States/UT's are requested to provide sanctioned year-wise fund requirements under IAY for completion of units and the funds available for their completion. The States/UT's may also indicate how they propose to bridge the gap in funding. This information may be sent to this Ministry latest by July 17, 2018. **If no information is received from the States/UT's within the indicated time, then it shall be assumed that the States/UT's have no information to furnish.** The requisite information can be sent on the following email id's.



Agenda points for the proposed meeting with State Governments to be held under the Chairmanship of Secretary Department of Rural Development.

- 1) Reconfirmation of the data provided by State Governments pertaining to IAY, including special projects sanctioned, if any.
- 2) Strategies & timelines to complete the incomplete IAY houses/special projects.
- 3) Action to be taken w.r.t. those IAY beneficiaries which the States/UT's think
 - i) May not be completed due to various reasons
 - ii) Where recovery factors have started such as FIR lodged etc.
- 4) Submission of documents and closure and settlement of accounts
 - i) UC
 - ii) Audit Reports
 - iii) Mandatory Certificates as mentioned in AIY Programme Guidelines.

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
