Performance Index Dashboard: Methodology for ranking of States/UTs

The Performance Index has been devised to assess the performance of States/UTs and ranking of States and UTs based on certain identified performance indicators. For the purpose of ranking, a consolidated score of each State/UT is calculated on real time basis on AwaasSoft based on scoring against the performance parameters. The Methodology for scoring against the parameters is provided below:

1. For all the states/UTs except Assam, Meghalaya and Jammu & Kashmir

The following parameters with assigned weightages are being considered for all the states/UTs except Assam, Meghalaya and Jammu & Kashmir:

2. For States of Jammu & Kashmir, Assam and Meghalaya:

The following parameters with assigned weightages are being considered for States of Jammu & Kashmir, Assam and Meghalaya:

On the basis of above mentioned methodology, the consolidated score calculated for each State/UT is used for ranking the States and UTs.

3. Methodology for breaking tie between two States/UTs:

Case 1: In case, the consolidated scores of two or more States/UTs come out to be equal and the ranks of such States/UTs are same then in order to break the tie, the scores against the parameter "Houses Completed out of MoRD Target" shall be used.

For example, the scores of two States/UTs "A" and "B" come out to be 57.78 on a particular day and their ranks coincide at number 5. In order to break the tie, the system shall consider their scores against the parameter "Houses Completed out of MoRD Target". If the score against this parameter is 24.45 for "A" and 21.22 for "B", then State/UT "A" would be ranked at number 5 and rank 6 would be assigned to State/UT "B".

Case 2: In case, the consolidated scores of two or more States/UTs come out to be equal and the scores against the parameter "Houses Completed out of MoRD Target" are also same for these States/UTs, then in order to break the tie, the scores against the parameter "Number of last installments (i.e. 3rd/4th installment, as applicable) paid out of MoRD Target" shall be used.

For example, the scores of two States/UTs "A" and "B" come out to be 57.78 on a particular day and their ranks coincide at number 5. Further, both the States/UTs have scored 24.45 against the parameter "Houses Completed out of MoRD Target". In order to break the tie, the system shall consider their scores against the parameter "Number of last installments (i.e. 3rd/4th installment, as applicable) paid out of MoRD Target". If the score against this parameter is 15.75 for "A" and 16.24 for "B", then State/UT "B" would be ranked at number 5 and rank 6 would be assigned to State/UT "A".
