**Subject: Allocation of additional targets under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin) for the financial year 2016-17.**

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, to realize the Government's commitment towards ensuring 'Housing For All' by 2022, the rural housing scheme has been restructured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) w.e.f 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016. The initial targets under PMAY-G for FY 2016-17 had been communicated to all States/UTs vide Ministry's communication No. G-20011/01/2015-RH (A/C) dated 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2016. Subsequently, targets were increased by 33% in the current financial year, within the overall target of one crore houses. Additional targets under PMAY-G for the year 2016-17 was communicated to all States/UTs vide DO letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> January, 2017. In this context, I am directed to forward herewith a Statement showing State-wise allocation of funds and category wise distribution of additional targets under PMAY(G) for the year 2016-17(Annexure-I).

2. The fund sharing pattern for the current financial year 2016-17 for PMAY(G) will be 60:40 between the Centre and States (90:10 in the 8 North Eastern States and 3 Himalayan States). In the case of UTs 100% of cost will be borne by the Centre.

3. You are requested to finalise district-wise and category-wise targets under intimation to this Ministry and enter the targets for districts and blocks on AwaasSoft. For States with IAP districts, necessary adjustment will be made in the financial allocation once the district wise targets have been finalized and intimated to the Ministry.

4. Any surrender of targets/change in category wise targets may be communicated to this Ministry immediately alongwith the district wise category wise targets. You are also requested to enter the targets for district and blocks on AwaasSoft before 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2017. Targets entered in the MIS would be deemed final if no communication is received from the States/UTs.

5. You are requested to issue necessary instructions informing all the Districts/ Blocks within your State to make preparation for issues of sanctions to beneficiaries
