Subject: State-wise Allocation of funds under Indira Awaas Yojana for the year 2015-16

Sir,

I am directed to forward herewith a Statement showing State-wise allocation of funds under IAY for the year 2015-16 (**Column 2 of Annexure**). It is also stated that the financial allocation has been made as per the guideline giving 75 per cent weight to rural housing shortage from the latest Census data and 25 per cent weight to poverty estimate.

2. It has also been decided in the Union Budget 2015-16 to rework the fund sharing pattern for the scheme during this financial year. The final decision on this is awaited. In view of the above, the tentative physical and the category-wise break up is shown in **Columns 3-7 of Annexure**. *It is stated that these are same as the targets given in 2014-15 and are subject to revision once the fund sharing pattern is finalised.* You are requested to finalise the district wise targets under intimation to this Ministry.

3. The first instalments would be released to all States/UTs who have availed of the second instalment in 2014-15 and to States/UTs who have submitted their complete consolidated proposals in the financial year 2014-15. All other States would have to submit consolidated proposals in the prescribed format for release of the first instalments. *The central allocation has been worked out assuming a 50:50 sharing pattern between centre and States. However final orders on the sharing pattern will be communicated to the States in due course.*

4. All fund releases under IAY would be made directly to the Consolidated Fund of the States and UTs with Legislatures and necessary provision has been made under Major Head '3601' and '3602' for release of programme funds to States and UTs respectively.

5. *It is also stated that starting 2015-16 the following changes in fund management under the scheme is to be operationalised*


- a. The Central and State share funds have to be pooled and maintained in one centralized bank account at the State level.
- b. All fund disbursements to beneficiaries' sanctioned houses in 2015-16 would be made into their bank/ post office accounts through the PFMS platform.
- c. The detailed advisory issued vide Ministry's letter dated 10th April, 2015 may be referred to.

6. It is also stated that AwaasSoft would be the only reporting platform available for reporting progress under the scheme. The online Monthly Progress Report stands disabled for any reporting in 2015-16. *Progress for 2014-15 may be updated immediately, since links for updation of progress in 2014-15 would also be disabled on 30th April 2015.*

7. You are requested to issue necessary instructions informing all the Districts/Blocks within your State to make preparations for issue of sanctions to the beneficiaries.
