Sub: Engagement of CSDCI accredited Training Providers to undertake pilot training of Rural Masons under Pradhan mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G)

Sir,

With reference to this Ministry's earlier communication No. J-11011/11/2015-RH-RBC dated 12th February, 2016 regarding pilot training of rural masons, States are advised to engage CSDCI accredited Training Providers to impart quality training under the pilot initiative. The following directions with regard to engagement of Training Providers may be adhered to by States funding the training initiative from administrative funds available under PMAY-G :

1. On-the-job training must be carried out at an IAY / PMAY-G house with the agreement of the beneficiary. Theoretical concepts / classroom training may be imparted at a suitable location close to the site itself to reduce the effort and expense in transporting trainees to the training site.
2. While the building materials for the training may be procured by the beneficiary using the IAY / PMAY-G funds, the cost of trainers may be paid to the Training provider as per the Uniform Cost norms laid out by the Government of India, with the current ceiling at Rs 30 per trainee per hour. The ceiling is inclusive of the cost of mobilization of trainees, procurement of raw materials, making available training infrastructure and common tools, provision of training materials to trainees as well as placement of trainees. Depending on the scope of work allocated to the Training Provider and considering the location of the training site (remoteness etc), decentralized and on-the-job nature of training, States may engage qualified Training Providers through a competitive bidding process subject to a ceiling of Rs 30 per trainee per hour.
3. It is recommended that the payment may be made to the training providers as per the following schedule :
