As you are aware, to realize the Government's commitment towards ensuring 'Housing For All' by 2022, the rural housing scheme has been restructured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) w.e.f.1st April 2016. The initial targets under PMAY-G for FY 2016-17 had been communicated to all States/UTs vide Ministry's communication No.G-20011/01/2015-RH(A/C) dated 28th June, 2016.

2. Subsequently, the Hon'ble PM, in his address to the nation on 31st December, 2016, has announced that targets under the Rural Housing Scheme in FY 2016-17 will be enhanced by 33%, within the overall target of one crore houses, to accelerate implementation of the scheme. In pursuance of the same, I am directed to forward herewith a Statement showing State/UT-wise distribution of additional targets under PMAY-G for the year 2016-17 (Annexure-I). The targets allocated to five States where the Model Code of Conduct is in operation along with the categorywise distribution of physical targets will be communicated by the Ministry after election process is over.

3. All States/UTs are requested to undertake necessary planning and preparation to mobilize resources to fast track construction of the additional houses. This would require expediting the process of finalization of permanent waitlist, registration of beneficiaries, geo tagging of existing dwellings and vacant landsite and sanctioning of houses.

4. It is requested that all State/UTs extend their full support and cooperation in realizing the mandate of PMAY-G.
