I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letters of even number dated 24th January, 2018 and 19th March, 2018 (copies enclosed) on the above mentioned subject and to say that based on the requests received from different State Governments mentioning reasons for not completing the task of identification of additional households and uploading the same on AwaasSoft using mobile application "Awaas+", the last date for completing the entire exercise of identification of additional households to be considered as beneficiary under PMAY-G is further been extended to 30th September, 2018.

2. It is, therefore, again requested that all States / UTs may adhere to the above mentioned time-frame so that requisite action on the part of Ministry of Rural Development can be initiated.

Subject: Identification of additional beneficiaries for inclusion in the
Permanent Wait List of PMAY-G – Procedure to be adopted – Reg.

Sir / Madam,

You are aware that the Framework for Implementation of PMAY-G provides for identification of households who though eligible for assistance under PMAY-G as per the specified parameters have not been included in the Permanent Wait List. Further, Ministry of Rural Development has also issued an advisory to all the States / UTs vide letter No. J-11012/02/2016-RH, dated 6th July, 2017 to identify such left out households and upload the identified households on AwaasSoft. Accordingly, various State Governments have initiated the process of identification of households who though eligible have not been included in the PWL of PMAY-G and also uploaded the details on AwaasSoft.

2. In this connection, it is stated that in order to ensure a uniform criteria for identification of such households is followed all through out the country, the following procedure has been prescribed :-

- I. States / UT to ensure the following while identification of the eligible households under PMAY-G
 - a. The households should either be houseless or living in zero, one and two room house with kutchra wall and kutchra roof as per SECC data.
 - b. The identified households should not fulfil any one of the 13 exclusion parameters specified in SECC-2011 and mentioned in Annexure-I of the FFI.
 - c. The definition of kutchra roof would mean "Roof made of Grass/Thatch/Bamboo etc., plastic / polythene, and hand made tiles) and kutchra wall would mean "Wall made of Grass/Thatch/Bamboo etc., plastic /
