Dear Colleague,

Please refer to DO letter No. 13011/05/2013-LRD dated 5<sup>th</sup> September 2018 from Hon'ble Union Minister of Rural Development, Panchayati Raj and Mines, Government of India to the Hon'ble Chief Minister / Administrator of your State/ UT about providing land to landless beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G).

2. Further, providing land to landless beneficiaries is crucial in achieving the target of construction of 1 crore houses. These landless beneficiaries are the most deserving PMAY-G beneficiaries. As reported by States/ UTs, so far only 56,694 (12%) PMAY-G beneficiaries have been provided land for house construction out of the identified 4,72,345 landless beneficiaries. The State and UT wise details on the same are enclosed for your perusal.

3. It is noteworthy that few States have taken significant steps in this regard; still the overall progress at the national level is far from satisfactory. Therefore, I request you to;

- i. Assess landlessness among PMAY-G beneficiaries from the entire Permanent Wait List (PWL), if not done earlier.
- ii. Review the status of house completion for those beneficiaries provided with land out of the identified landless beneficiaries in your State/ UT.
- iii. Prepare a plan to provide land to landless beneficiaries with timelines.
- iv. Apprise this Ministry on the above, i.e. status on identified landless beneficiaries, beneficiaries provided with land and steps being taken with timelines for providing land to all landless beneficiaries, etc.

4. I request you to kindly expedite action to provide land to all the deprived landless beneficiaries in your State to get benefit under a PMAY-G, which will facilitate achieving the goal of "Housing for All" by 2022.
