**Subject: Withdrawal of targets allocated under PMAY-G from Socio-Economic Caste Census – 2011 based Permanent Wait List (PWL) and finalized Awaas+ (2018) list -reg.**

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware, PMAY-G is being implemented in partnership with the State Governments to realize the noble goal of "Housing for All" in rural areas. The Union Cabinet has approved the continuation of the scheme till March 2024 for the completion of the remaining houses within the cumulative target of 2.95 crore houses. As of 26.12.2023, more than 2.94 crore houses have been sanctioned and 2.52 crore houses have been completed. The balance targets are to be sanctioned & completed on an urgent basis to achieve the cumulative target of completion of 2.95 crore houses within the set deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.


2. I would like to refer to the letters of even no. dated 29<sup>th</sup> May 2023, 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2023, 25<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 & 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 through which the Ministry had conveyed the withdrawal of targets in respect of gaps in sanction due to deletions of ineligible households who were sanctioned earlier. This withdrawal was on basis of the house sanctions as of 20.10.2023.

3. In this regard, with the approval of the competent authority, the gaps in sanction due to deletion of sanctions of **36,524 houses (15,333 houses from SECC 2011 based PWL and 21,191 houses from finalized Awaas+ 2018 list)** from the States/UTs have again been withdrawn as per details of sanctions as of 21.12.2023. The State/UT wise details are given in **Annexure-I** (SECC 2011 based PWL) and **Annexure-II** (finalized Awaas+ 2018 list). The targets are being updated on AwaasSoft.

4. Further, it may be noted that the targets for States of Assam (2,386), Himachal Pradesh (3,783), Jammu & Kashmir (2,711), Manipur (3,412), Tamil Nadu (7,831), Uttar Pradesh (6) and Uttarakhand (1,662) have not been withdrawn and an extension in the deadline for sanction has been given to these States/UTs for 15 more days till 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 in wake of special circumstances. These States are requested to confirm the final number of houses which can be sanctioned at the earliest to this Ministry within extended deadline of 9<sup>th</sup> January, 2024 failing which the Ministry would be constrained to consider for withdrawal of the remaining unsanctioned houses and re-allocation to other State.
