Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 6th September, 2017 (copy enclosed) forwarding the communication received from Secretary, Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DAR&PG) regarding Government of India's scheme of 'Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration' to acknowledge, recognise and reward the extraordinary and innovative work done by Districts/ Organisations of the Central and State Governments.

2. In the reference letter, it was conveyed that for year 2017, PMAY-G has been identified as a priority programme for the awards to be presented on the Civil Services Day, 2018. It was also requested that the scheme 'PMs Award for Excellence in Public Administration' may be well publicised so that the Districts can take appropriate actions for enhancing their performance in implementation of PMAY-G.

3. In this connection, I am directed to say that a web portal has been developed for online registration of Districts for choosing the priority program to compete for the PMs Awards for Excellence in Public Administration. The link of the portal (<https://nceg.gov.in/pmawards/public/login>) is available on the website of DARPG (www.darpg.gov.in). In light of the same, all the states are requested to sensitize the districts and advise them to participate in the competition by registering online.

4. Further, the states may advise the districts to expedite the process of implementation of PMAY-G and improve their performance in order to win the award.




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It may please be noted that the period of consideration for evaluation of performance of the districts is from 1st April, 2016 to 31st December, 2017. Therefore, the states may advise the districts to consider the following in order to improve the performance in the following 2 months:

- The implementing units may identify the gaps pertaining to registration, sanctioning, 1st instalment paid, completion, uploading of Gram Sabha resolutions and Permanent Waitlist (PWL) on AwaasSoft and try to bridge the gap by reviewing their performance as per the physical progress reports available on (<http://pmayg.nic.in/netiay/home.aspx>).
- Since, convergence with other schemes, planning for smooth execution and IEC initiatives are some of the parameters that would be considered for evaluation of performance, the states may advise the districts to undertake the following:
- Painting the names of beneficiaries appearing in PWL on the walls of gram panchayat office and public buildings;
- Celebration of Awaas Diwas, grih pravesh, bhoomi puja;
- Training, assessment, certification of rural masons as per Qualification Packs (QP) developed by the Ministry;
- Convergence for electrification, sustainable energy, rain water harvesting
Facilitating an environment for uninterrupted supply of construction materials etc.

5. In this regard, the State/UTs are once again requested for increasing the participation in the scheme of PM's Awards for excellence in Public Administration and for accelerating the progress of implementation of the programme.
