**Sub : Review of Pilot training of masons under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-
Gramin (PMAY-G) in Kurud Block, Chhattisgarh**

Sir.

This is with reference to the meeting and joint review of the on-going pilot training at Parkhanda village, Kurud block in Dhamtari district by officials from the state government and MoRD on 7th May 2016. It was evident that while the pace of work is impressive, there are several areas of improvement with regard to the quality of teaching, regularity of classes and monitoring of quality of work by master trainers.

2. in view of the above shortcomings, it is advised that a CSDCI accredited Training Provider may be engaged to effectively address issues related to quality of construction and monitoring of training outcomes. The State may ensure that the existing trainees are provided quality training so that they are prepared for assessment and eventual certification. The state may use administrative funds available under PMAY-G for expediting training of rural masons under the on-going pilot.
