**Subject: Revision of targets under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) for
FY 2016-17- regarding**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the state's letter dated 18th November, 2016, on the subject mentioned above, which seeks clarification and guidance on targets and allocation under PMAY-G for FY 2016-17. Clarification regarding the points raised by the State is given below for kind perusal:

Targets of 4,30,065 houses communicated to the State vide D.O. letter dated 28th June, 2016 will remain unchanged. However, targets may be downwardly revised by the State to account for higher unit assistance of Rs1.3 lakh/dwelling in IAP districts while keeping the financial allocation of Rs 322032.52 lakhs unchanged. Atleast 60% of the targets, after downward revision, shall be earmarked for SC/STs. Remaining targets, after earmarking, may be allocated to Others (OBCs and General castes) or Minorities. Revised minority targets of 69,167 houses, as communicated in the minutes of the Annual Action Plan 2016-17, could be met from targets allocated to SC/ST and Others (OBCs and General Castes), in case of Minority households falling in these categories.

If the State decides to opt for Minority targets of 1,17,934 houses conveyed in the afore mentioned D.O. letter dated 28th June, 2016, the difference of 48,767 houses will be adjusted from Minority targets for FY 2017-18. The higher Minority targets of 1,17,934 houses will have to be met from overall targets of 4,30,065 houses allocated to the State.
