Dear *Colleague*

I am pleased to acknowledge the tremendous enthusiasm of all States and UTs in the implementation of PMAY-G scheme. During the years 2016-17 to 2018-2019, out of the target of 1 crore houses, a total of 93,65,017 houses have been sanctioned and further 76.31 lakh houses have been completed till the end of FY 2019-20 although many states have requested for extra time to upload completed houses on AwaasSoft owing to the General Elections.

2. During implementation of PMAY-G, I am sure the States and UTs experimented with and developed novel ways to address various challenges and to make implementation of PMAY-G better leading to faster achievement of targets allotted by the Ministry.

3. It is important to document and share such innovative ways with others across States so that we learn from the experiences of others. Accordingly, I suggest you to organise Block, District and State level experience sharing workshops, compile them and then send them to the Ministry so that they can be compiled for the benefit of all. Some of the areas on innovation and lessons learnt may include accelerating house completion rate, tackling issues of difficult areas, improving IT platform use, addressing beneficiary related issues, ensuring quality of houses (sustainable housing and use of local materials), ensuring timely payments to the beneficiaries including liaisoning with the Banks etc., convergence of different programmes, measures taken to strengthen transparency, efficient Grievance Redressal System, etc.

4. Ministry is also planning to organise experience / best-practices sharing workshops for the benefit of all very soon and the above compilation would come in handy for sharing the innovations across States / UTs.
