Subject: Planning of sustained supply of Brick for construction of houses under PMAY-G.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that to achieve the objective of "Housing for All" by 2022 Ministry of Rural Development is implementing the rural housing scheme Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G). The target set under the PMAY-G is to construct 1.00 Crore houses by 2018-19 and 2.95 crore houses by 2022 in rural areas of the country. These houses have a minimum size of 25 square meter. The number of houses to be constructed in different states under PMAY-G is enclosed.

2. Construction of these number of houses would require a sustained supply of good quality construction material viz., cement, steel, sand, bricks, etc. across the country. All the States / UTs have been advised to prepare an advance plan to ensure adequate availability of quality construction material so that the beneficiaries of PMAY-G do not face any problems to procure quality construction materials.

3. The Association of Brick Kiln Industries has a central role to play in making the members across the country aware of the target of the houses to be constructed under PMAY-G in different States / UTs to provide them enough time to organize production to meet the construction demand under PMAY-G. This also needs to be followed up at various levels at your end.
