Subject: Implementation of PMAY-G – Reporting of progress on different aspects of implementation - Reg..

Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana – Gramin (PMAY-G) is being implemented by Ministry of Rural Development to fulfil the objective of Government “Housing for All” by 2022. Under PMAY-G, the huge target set i.e., construction of 1.00 crore houses by 2018-19 and 2.95 crore houses by 2021-22 is to be achieved in a short span time.

2. In order to achieve the huge target within a short span of time, various activities that are involved in the implementation of the scheme needs to be carried out in a time bound manner. All the activities involved in the implementation are linked with one another and any deviation would result in non-achievement of the target set under PMAY-G.

3. Ministry of Rural Development with a view to ensure smooth implementation of the scheme of PMAY-G and to monitor the various activities involved, has developed a template (copy enclosed) to report the progress on different aspects / parameters of the scheme. This template has been prepared based on the action points that had emerged during the meeting of Empowered Committee that finalized the Annual Action Plan of the States / UTs.

4. The progress made by the State/UT on different aspects / parameters of the scheme need to be furnished in the prescribed template as per the prescribed reporting period i.e. Monthly or Quarterly. The information is required to be provided as on the last day of the month/Quarter, as applicable and may be provided by 5th day of the succeeding month; so that gaps that exist in the implementation of PMAY-G are identified and requisite action can be taken to address the gaps.

5. In this connection, I request you to direct the officers concerned with the implementation of PMAY-G to furnish the progress report of PMAY-G in the prescribed format which is enclosed by 15th of every month.
