Subject:- Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G) –Activities to be
undertaken for smooth roll out of the scheme – Reg.

Sir / Madam

I am directed to say that the Ministry of Rural Development has released the funds for implementation of the scheme of PMAY-G to the States / UTs whose Annual Action Plans were presented and approved. The Framework for Implementation of PMAY-G, which details the processes involved in the implementation of the scheme, is under finalisation and would be released shortly.

2. You are aware that one of the main characteristics of PMAY-G is that, all the activities from fund transfer to capturing the physical progress is to be carried out electronically through MIS AwaasSoft. With the release of funds the States / UTs have to undertake certain activities for the smooth roll out of the scheme. Till the Framework for Implementation is released, the States/UTs, in the interim, can be guided by the following :

I Freezing of bank accounts of the Beneficiary

It should be ensured that the bank account details of the beneficiaries of PMAY-G, who are selected for receiving assistance during the current financial year, is entered correctly on AwasSoft. After verification of the account by PFMS the same is returned to Block level officer for freezing. Block level officer must once again check the account details before freezing. **The accounts details once frozen after this three step verification process will not be changeable.**

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
