Subject :- Operationalisation of State Nodal Account - Clarification - Reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.170/PMAYG/2017 , dated 23rd February, 2017 on the above mentioned subject. With regard to the operationalization of State Nodal Account, the following is clarified:-

- a) The provisions in Para 10.2 of Framework for Implementation as quoted by Finance Dept. of Govt. of Uttar Pradesh states only about the procedure of transferring funds from Government of India to the State / UT Governments. It does not speak about utilisation of the fund for implementing the rural housing scheme (PMAY-G).
- b) The provisions in Para 10.1 of the Framework for Implementation speaks about the procedure of utilisation of the fund for implementing the rural housing scheme (PMAY-G). The provision states as follows:-

“The States / UTs shall maintain single savings bank account in a Scheduled Commercial Bank at the State level. This account shall henceforth be referred to as the State Nodal Account (SNA). The annual Central allocation (assistance for house construction and administrative funds) as well as the matching state share shall be deposited in the SNA by the States. The State/UT Governments shall communicate the details of the Bank, Branch and Account number, IFSC code etc. to the Ministry. The SNA shall also be registered in AwaasSoft and with PFMS.

This SNA shall be operated upon only electronically through a Fund Transfer Order (FTO) and no other mode of withdrawal from it shall be permissible.”
